Where Do I Start?

The Tufin Service Delivery Partner Certification is available free of charge as a series of online courses on a dedicated learning management system and includes access to hands-on virtual lab environments. The hands-on labs are accompanied by a training manual to give training participants the opportunity to apply their knowledge in real-world scenarios.

The self-paced learning system allows you to review material covered both before and after taking the relevant certification exam.

TCSE 1 and TCSE 2 certifications are valid for one year. TCSE 3 and 4 certifications are valid for two years. SDP certification is valid for 2 years. Courses are regularly updated to cover newly added features for recertification.

Tufin Certification FAQs

What is required for TCSE Certification?

To earn a TCSE or SDP certification you must complete the applicable learning plan and pass all exams with a score of 80%.

Can I take the certification exam without taking the training course?

The certification exam is currently offered only to users who have taken the training course.

How long is the certification good for?

TCSE 1 and TCSE 2 certifications are good for 1 year.
TCSE 3 and TCSE 4 certifications are good for 2 years.
Service Delivery Partner certification is good for 2 years.

What if I've taken a training course in the past?

If more than a year has passed, you will need to take the TCSE Recertification course.

How many chances do I get to take the exam?

You have two attempts to take the exam in a 24-hour period.

How long do I have to wait to retake the exam if I fail both attempts?

24 hours.

What is the process for renewing my certifications?

Log onto [Tufin Academy](#) and take the relevant Recertification Course.
